

Southwest Airlines Baggage Information

Baggage Allowance

Southwest allows two (2) checked pieces of baggage per ticketed Customer. Size and weight limitations apply.

Excess Baggage

Each piece of baggage in excess of the free baggage allowance specified above that is not in excess of 62 inches (L+W+H) and 50 lbs. or less will be accepted for a charge of \$75.00 per item one-way. Excess baggage which is also overweight or oversized will be charged excess baggage plus the applicable oversize or overweight charge.

Weight and Size Allowance

Southwest will accept the first two checked bags for free provided that the bags do not exceed 50 lbs and 62 inches (L+W+H). Overweight items from 51 to 100 pounds and oversized items in excess of 62 inches but not more than 80 inches will be accepted for a charge of \$75.00 per item one-way. Only one \$75.00 charge applies if the piece is both oversized and overweight, regardless of the weight as long as it does not exceed 100 lbs. Excess baggage which is also overweight or oversized will be charged excess baggage plus the applicable oversize or overweight charge.

Each ticketed Customer can bring free of charge 1 carryon bag and 1 personal item

Carryon bag dimensions are limited to **10 x 16 x 24 inches**.

- You must store your carryon in the overhead bin. Storing it wheels facing out helps us get wheels up faster!
- If you're traveling with a pet, carriers are counted as either your personal item or carryon.
- **A friendly reminder:** If your carryon does not fit the dimensions above, we will be forced to check it at the gate. It will be safely stowed below the aircraft for the duration of your flight, and you will pick it up at baggage claim, not the gate, upon arrival to your final destination. Assistive devices and strollers may be claimed at the gate/jet bridge.

Personal-type items include purses, briefcases, cameras, food containers, or laptops (case included).

- Your personal item must be stored under the seat in front of you, fitting within **18.5 x 8.5 x 13.5 inch dimensions**.
- **A friendly reminder:** If your personal item does not fit under your seat, you will be asked to place it in an overhead bin.
