



As a new or returning member into the Grafton High School chapter of Tri-M, students must agree to the following requirements:

- (1) Members will be responsible for paying yearly dues of \$20. These dues can be submitted to the chapter treasurer at the first meeting in September. Checks may be made out to GHBPA. Please write Tri-M in the memo section.
- (2) All Tri-M members must be currently enrolled in a band or chorus class at Grafton High School.
- (3) Members must audition for High School District Band or Chorus or participate in High School Solo and Ensemble or comparable with the approval of the faculty advisor.
- (4) Members must participate in one of the following additional performance activities:
 - an additional GHS ensemble (e.g., Jazz, Pit, Musical Cast, a different concert band or choir), or
 - a musical community group (e.g., Youth Symphony or other Chorus, Community Chorus, or chorus or instrumental musician with your church) or
 - actively taking private lessons, or
 - actively mentoring middle school students in music
- (5) Tri-M members must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.5 in music classes and 3.2 overall. GPAs will be confirmed by the Guidance Office at the end of each school year.
- (6) Members will be required to complete 10 service hours during the school year. As part of those required service hours, members must perform in at least one Tri-M sponsored concert (elementary school, community concert...) and are required to usher for at least two concerts. The remaining service hours may come from other band, chorus, or community service activities. Service hours must be documented on the slips provided in the band room or sign-in at event. Please also keep records of your hours and confirm them with the Tri-M secretary.
- (7) Tri-M members should make every effort to attend monthly chapter meetings and must attend a minimum of 5 meetings during the school year.

FAILURE TO MEET THESE REQUIREMENTS WILL RESULT IN DISMISSAL FROM Tri-M SOCIETY AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CHAPTER FACULTY ADVISOR. SENIORS WILL NOT RECEIVE THEIR HONOR CORDS, WHILE UNDERCLASSMEN WILL BE PUT ON PROBATION STATUS UNTIL REQUIREMENTS ARE MET OR ASKED TO REAPPLY FOR THEIR SENIOR YEAR.
